



SDG ART COMPETITION 2023



Terms & Conditions of Entry

1. The competition is open to all Isle of Man residents and students whose main residence is the Isle of Man.
2. There are two classes of entry: Under 18 and 18 & Over.
 - Under 18s are asked to produce a poster using either a drawing, illustration or painting. The finished item should be no larger than A3 size.
 - Entrants in the 18 & Over category may choose any medium to respond to the brief but entries must be easily portable.
3. All entries should be original and respond to the theme of "Food for All".
4. Entries should be clearly marked and submitted with a completed entry form to the One World Centre, Howard Street, Douglas IM1 2EQ the closing date or, in the case of digital art, by email to info@owciom.org. Please call 310191 to drop off an entry in person.
5. The final closing date is Monday 31st July 2023, however entries may be submitted at any time prior to the closing date.
6. A written explanation of the work can also be submitted if desired (no more than 100 words) although this will not form part of the judging.
7. Prizes will be awarded to the overall winner in each category. The 18 & Over winner will receive a £100 Shoprite Voucher and the Under 18 overall winner will receive a selection of art materials. Smaller value prizes will be awarded to the Under 18 runners up and the two special awards in the 18 & Over group – these may be art materials or vouchers for local stores.
8. Any entries submitted may be used for press and publicity purposes. By entering into the competition, you allow us to display, copy and publicise the entries to help raise awareness of the Sustainable Development Goals.
9. Entries in the Under 18 Category will require parent or guardian's permission. Teachers may submit works from schools provided appropriate permissions are in place.
10. Entries will be judged on creative expression, understanding of and relevance to the theme and impact.
11. By submitting a piece of artwork, the entrant is deemed to have understood and accepted the following terms and conditions:
 - All artwork submitted must be the original idea and creation of the entrant and must not infringe anyone else's rights.
 - The artwork must not contain any personal information.
 - It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that any person who appears in their artwork has given appropriate permissions for their image to be used in accordance with these terms.
 - By submitting artwork, all entrants provide their consent for their artwork to be used, free of charge, for other activity associated with the promotion of the Sustainable Development Goals.
 - By submitting artwork, entrants and persons submitting on their behalf agree that the One World Centre Isle of Man will use their personal information for administering this competition, press and advertising purposes, including publication (online or in printed form) of name (and age if under 18) alongside their artwork, and in accordance with our Privacy Policy.
 - Entrants agree to the cropping or other minor alterations if necessary to their artwork when used in accordance with these terms.
12. The judges' decision is final.
