Terms & Conditions of Entry

1. The competition is open to all Isle of Man children and young people of school age whose main residence is in the Isle of Man.
2. There are two classes of entry: Primary school age and Secondary school age (based on age during 2025-26 academic year).
3. Entrants are asked to produce a poster with a finished size no larger than A3.
4. All entries should be original and share a message about action to look after life on land. Digital entries will be accepted although AI-generated images are not allowed.
5. Entries should be clearly marked and submitted with a completed entry form to the One World Centre, Howard Street, Douglas IM1 2EQ by the closing date or, in the case of digital art, by email toinfo@owciom.org. Please call 310191 to drop off an entry in person.
6. The final closing date is Friday 7th August 2026, however entries may be submitted at any time prior to this.
7. Entrants are encouraged to write a short explanation (no more than 100 words) on the back of their entry about why they have chosen their message/image.
8. Prizes will be awarded to the overall winner and two runners up in each category. The winners will each receive creative vouchers to the value of £50 and the runners up vouchers to the value of £25.
9. Any entries submitted may be used for press and publicity purposes. By entering into the competition, you allow us to display, copy and publicise the entries to help raise awareness of the Sustainable Development Goals.
10. Entries will require a parent's or guardian's permission although teachers may submit works from schools provided appropriate permissions are in place, including around publicity.
11. Judges will be appointed by the One World Centre (Isle of Man) and entries will be judged on creative impact and understanding of - and relevance to - the theme.
12. By submitting a piece of artwork, the entrant is deemed to have understood and accepted the following terms and conditions:
 - All artwork submitted must be the original idea and creation of the entrant and must not infringe anyone else's rights.
 - The artwork must not contain any personal information.
 - It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that any person who appears in their artwork has given appropriate permissions for their image to be used in accordance with these terms.
 - By submitting artwork, all entrants provide their consent for their artwork to be used, free of charge, for other activity associated with the promotion of the Sustainable Development Goals.
 - By submitting artwork, entrants and persons submitting on their behalf agree that the One World Centre Isle of Man will use their personal information for administering this competition, press and advertising purposes, including publication (online or in printed form) of name and age alongside their artwork, and in accordance with our Privacy Policy.
 - Entrants agree to the cropping or other minor alterations if necessary to their artwork when used in accordance with these terms.
13. The judges' decision is final.
